

# Bibliography

All Grad Challenge Tri-search papers will use the MLA format for consistency and ease of evaluation.

\*The only deviation from the MLA format is that you must include in the bibliography the **phone numbers and/or e-mail addresses** of the people you interviewed.

Below is an example of how you would arrange your bibliography in alphabetical order. Remember, this is a list of **all** references used for your paper, not just those you have cited. It is not necessary to separate electronic from print sources. It should be **single-spaced**. Indent the second and following lines 5 spaces. Keep the internet address on one line.
