<b>6.2 Brainstorming Solutions</b>	Brainstorms all possible solutions and able to build off from other's ideas. Consistently willing to think outside the box.	Brainstorms possible solutions. Often thinks outside the box.	Brainstorms some solutions.	Does not brainstorm.
<b>6.3 Prioritizing and Initiating</b>	Logically compares possible solutions and identifies potential obstacles. In an organized manner selects and tries the chosen solution.	Compares possible solutions and identifies potential obstacles to achieving desired outcome. Selects and tries chosen solution.	Compares some solutions and potential obstacles but in an incomplete manner.	Does not compare solutions and potential obstacles.
<b>6.4 Refining and Reflecting</b>	Reflects and identifies strengths and weaknesses of prior attempts. Suggests appropriate adjustments for subsequent trials.	Reflects and identifies strengths and weaknesses of prior attempts. Willingly cooperates with implementing new solutions.	Reflects but does not share with the group.	Does not reflect.
